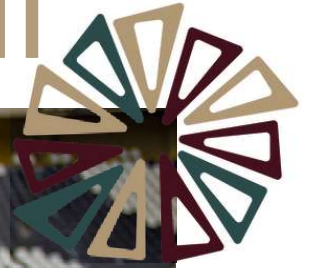

Empowering over 1,200 vulnerable children in the Lowveld through holistic care and mentorship.



Sinani, a dedicated non-profit based in the Lowveld, operates with a full-time staff of 15 field workers and 45 care workers across ten communities. Their life centre model provides holistic care to over 1,200 orphaned and vulnerable children. Unlike typical feeding schemes, Sinani goes beyond simply providing food; they build mentorship relationships with the children and youth. Sinani's team members are committed to knowing each child's name, story, and circumstances. Care workers visit homes to identify the most vulnerable children who need to be invited to the centres. At these centres, children participate in various activities designed to help them reach their full potential.

One of their standout programs is a sports initiative that began with the Sinani Premier League. This league has grown to include 22 teams—6 girls' netball teams and the rest soccer teams. For the past three years, the championship games have been held at Mbombela Stadium. Other initiatives include an Arts Academy, Foundations for Farming, development opportunities, camps, and engagement with international teams and visitors. Last year, Sinani received the KLCBT community service award, recognizing their diverse and effective approach to empowering and equipping children.
